- All questions carry equal marks. Total Marks: 100
- The question paper consists of 20 questions each in four sections namely Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics and Engineering. Out of the total 80 questions candidate has choice of solving ANY 20 questions (Not necessary from one section).
- You will be given 120 minutes to answer all questions.
- Please do not attempt more than 20 questions. In the event of the candidate attempting more than 20 questions, please note that only first 20 questions will be taken for evaluation and rest ignored.
- There is **NO NEGATIVE** marks for wrong answer.
- Non-programmable calculator allowed if necessary.
- You can use the navigation on the screen to modify or review the answers any time during the exam before submitting.
- Every question has multiple alternative responses. Select the **MOST APPROPRIATE** response by clicking the circle corresponding to that option and click **Next** to move forward.
- You may mark question as invalid in case multiple answer option are similar or question is incorrect.
- You can use **Mark for Review** check box given at the top left corner of the screen for review and Questions Marked for review will appear in **Blue** colour in the navigation box.
- You will be allowed to submit the exam after 60 minutes. You can submit the exam if you have completed answering all 20 questions.
- Once submitted, you cannot access the exam, please be careful before you submit the exam.
- The exam will get submitted automatically at the end of stipulated time. All answers will be saved and will be evaluated.
