Desirable: NET/GATE qualification. Knowledge of computer applications including web-searching, MS-Office and report writing.

SFFaN:

- (i) First Class Master's or equivalent post graduate degree in Packaging/Polymer Science/Polymer Science and Technology/Printing/Paper technology/Food Science and Technology/Pharma/Material Science.
- OR
- (ii) First Class ME, M.Tech. or equivalent postgraduate degree in Plastic and polymer Engineering/Printing and Paper Technology/Food Process Engineering/ /Pharma/Material Science/Chemical Engineering or equivalent.

Desirable: NET/GATE qualification. Knowledge of computer applications including web-searching, MS-Office, report writing and Handling instruments like HPLC, GCMC, ICP-OES, DSC, FTIR.
